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**In the Year Two Thousand Nine**  
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An Act Relative to Health Insurance Claims of Employees..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, health care  
2 insurers must provide benefits to insured claimants seeking reasonable and necessary medical  
3 services in all cases in which an alleged industrial injury has not been accepted by a workers'  
4 compensation insurer, and in all cases prior to the issuance of a conference order by an  
5 administrative judge pursuant to section 10 of chapter 152 of the General Laws directing the  
6 provision of medical benefits under sections 13 and 30 of chapter 152 of the General Laws.
