Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, section 113B of
2	chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended
3	by inserting in line 221, after the word "incident.", the following sentence:- "Driving a motor
4	vehicle that has an expired inspection sticker shall not be considered a surchargeable incident."
