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**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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**In the Year Two Thousand Nine**  
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An Act relative to Public Transit Users.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the sixth paragraph the following  
3 paragraph: -

4           In fixing and establishing classification of risks, the commissioner shall provide for  
5 appropriate reductions in the premium charges for those insurance holders who present less risk  
6 by taking public transit. The eligible commuters are determined by those who provide insurers  
7 with evidence of seven months of commuter passes from a qualified transit system, as  
8 determined by the insurer and who do not drive their automobile to work or school more than ten  
9 days per month. The commissioner shall establish a specific reduction of a minimum of 20 per  
10 cent in total premium charges for these eligible public transit commuters.
