Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 99 of Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended after line 349 by adding the following new text:-
3	Seventeenth. Nothing listed in this section shall prohibit a company from issuing a
4	contract to insure against loss by fire or other perils that excludes coverages for wind based
5	damages.
6	SECTION 2. The Massachusetts Property Insurance Underwriting Association, as
7	established under Chapter 175C of the General Laws, shall be hereby directed to develop and
8	implement a residual market for wind based damages, for applicants who are unable to obtain
9	such coverage in the voluntary market.
