An Act prohibiting drug switching payments..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 10 of Chapter 1760 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
2	following subsection:-

3	(d) No contract between a carrier, including a dental or vision carrier, and a participating
4	provider shall include any incentive plan that includes a specific payment to the participating
5	provider as an inducement to change a prescription for a drug or medical product issued to a
6	covered person from one specific drug or medical product to another. Nothing in this subsection
7	shall prohibit incentive plans that (1) do not make reference to any specific prescription drug or
8	medical product and (2) comply with the provisions of subsection (b). The commissioner may
9	impose a fine of \$10,000 per violation of this subsection.
