An Act relating to the standard fire insurance policy..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 99 of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding after clause Twelfth A the following new clause:—

3           Twelfth B. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a commercial policy  
4 issued in compliance with this section may exclude coverage for loss by fire or other perils  
5 insured against if the fire or other perils insured against were caused directly or indirectly by  
6 terrorism.
