An Act relative to the salaries of members of the Parole Board..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 27 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998  
2   official version, in lines 43 to 46 by striking out the words “The positions of chairman and each  
3   of the other members shall be classified in accordance with section forty-five of chapter thirty  
4   and the salaries shall be determined in accordance with section forty-six C of said chapter thirty.”  
5   and inserting in place thereof the following:- “The salaries of the positions of the chairman and  
6   each of the members shall be seventy-five and forty-seven hundredths percent of the salary of the  
7   chief justice of district court department.”
