An Act relative to creditable service..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended in
2	subdivision (2) paragraph (b) by inserting the following sentence at the end thereof: Any
3	permanent-intermittent or call firefighter who is appointed as a permanent member of a fire
4	department in a city or town other than the city or town in which he performed duty as a
5	permanent-intermittent or call firefighter shall be entitled to credit for such service; provided that
6	such service shall not be credited until such member has paid into the annuity saving fund of
7	each system, in one sum or installments, upon such terms and conditions as the board shall
8	prescribe, makeup payments, for each year of creditable service sought of an amount equal to ten
9	percent of the regular annual compensation for service as a permanent-intermittent or call
10	firefighter.
