An Act authorizing the board of assessors of the city of Quincy to grant tax abatements to certain military personnel..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the board of  
2   assessors of the City of Quincy, may grant, retroactive to fiscal year 2002, real and personal  
3   property tax abatements, up to 100 per cent of the total tax assessed to members of the  
4   Massachusetts National guard and to reservists on active duty in foreign countries, for the fiscal  
5   year they performed such service subject to eligibility criteria to be established by the board of  
6   assessors. The authority to grant abatements under this act shall expire after fiscal 2010 unless  
7   extended by a vote of the Quincy City Council.
