Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 58A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002
- 2 official edition, is amended in line 28 by inserting after the words "or both," with the following
- 3 words:- "or persons over the age of 65 who file an appeal from the board of assessors and with a
- 4 gross income of 200% of the federal poverty level shall pay a entry fee of more than twenty-five
- 5 dollars."
