## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to state tax deductions for gambling losses..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any resident of
2	the Commonwealth required to report gambling earnings as income on their state income tax
3	form shall be allowed to offset those winnings by claiming an itemized deduction for any
4	gambling losses sustained during the taxable year for which they are filing, to the extent
5	allowable under federal law; provided, however, that the individual must also itemize these
6	deductions on his federal income tax return.
