An Act to debar employers who violate federal immigration laws from contracting with the Commonwealth..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended in Section 29F(c), in the  
2 first line by removing the word “may” after the word “Debarment” and replacing it with the  
3 word “shall” and by removing the following words: “but, debarment shall be imposed in all  
4 causes where debarment is required by law.”

5           SECTION 2. Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended in Section 29F(c)(1) in  
6 the last line, by adding the following after the word “environment;”

7           (x) a violation of federal law prohibiting the employment of “unauthorized aliens”;
