An Act to debar employers who violate federal immigration laws from contracting with the Commonwealth..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended in Section 29F(c), in the
2	first line by removing the word "may" after the word "Debarment" and replacing it with the
3	word "shall" and by removing the following words: "but, debarment shall be imposed in all
4	causes where debarment is required by law."
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended in Section 29F(c)(1) in
6	the last line, by adding the following after the word "environment;"
7	(x) a violation of federal law prohibiting the employment of "unauthorized aliens";
