An Act Relative to Increased Efficiencies in State Government..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. “Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary, the state treasurer  
2 shall furnish by electronic means a check stub or pay slip to every person who receives  
3 compensation from the Commonwealth and whose compensation is provided to them by direct  
4 deposit, unless such person does not have an electronic mail address provided by and maintained  
5 by the Commonwealth. The treasurer shall continue to provide paper checks stubs and pay slips  
6 to all such persons who receive a paper check from the Commonwealth and to those who do not  
7 have an electronic mail address provided by and maintained by the Commonwealth. Any person  
8 who does not wish to receive their check stub or pay slip electronically may request to continue  
9 to receive a paper copy of their check stub or pay slip so long as they provide written notice to  
10 the treasurer.”
