An Act relative to gas meter readings..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Section 119A
- 2 of Chapter 164 of the General Laws of Massachusetts as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition is
- 3 hereby amended by adding, after the first sentence, the following: "Billing of customers shall be
- 4 based on actual readings. An estimate may only be used in an extraordinary situation where gas
- 5 meters are inaccessible or unable to be read."
- 6 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
- 7 department shall have the right to promulgate rules regarding actual meter readings or clarifying
- 8 instances in which estimates may be used.
- 9 SECTION. 3 The department shall establish a suitable punishment for each violation.
- SECTION 4. This section shall take effect on June 1, 2009 and shall have no effect on
- services provided or bills levied prior to June 1, 2009.
