An Act Relative to Octane Ratings..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1: Section 28A of chapter 98 of the Massachusetts General laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 "Regular" gasoline shall be defined to mean liquefied petroleum gasoline with an octane
- 4 rating of 87. No one shall advertise and/or sell "regular" liquefied petroleum gasoline with an
- 5 octane rating of more or less than 87.
