An Act eliminating certain paid holidays..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: Clause 18 of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out the following:- "Legal holiday' shall also include, with respect to Suffolk county  
3 only, March seventeenth and June seventeenth, or the day following when said days occur on  
4 Sunday; provided, however, that the words "legal holiday" as used in section forty-five of  
5 chapter one hundred and forty-nine shall not include March seventeenth, or the day following  
6 when said day occurs on Sunday."
