An Act to Promote Pedestrian Responsibility.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 18A of chapter 90 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence of the first paragraph, and  
3   inserting in place thereof, the following sentence;

4           Whoever violates any provision of any such rule shall be punished by a fine of fifty  
5   dollars for the first, one hundred dollars for the second or third such offense committed by such  
6   person within the jurisdiction of the district court in the particular calendar year, and by a fine of  
7   two hundred and fifty dollars for the fourth or subsequent such offense so committed in such  
8   calendar year.

9           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect at the commencement of the first fiscal year  
10   following enactment of this act.
