An Act protecting health care providers from violence..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 13I of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
2	official edition, is hereby amended by striking out the language in the section and inserting in
3	place thereof the following language:
4	Section 13I. Whoever commits an assault or assault and battery on an emergency medical
5	technician, an ambulance operator, an ambulance attendant, or a health care provider as defined
6	in section 1 of chapter 111, while said technician, operator, attendant, or provider is treating or
7	transporting a person in the line of duty, shall be punished by imprisonment in the house of
8	correction for not less than ninety days nor more than two and one-half years, or by a fine of not
9	less than five hundred nor more than five thousand dollars, or both.
