An Act relative to income verification of non-custodial parents..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary the probate and  
2 family court, in consultation with the department of children and families and the department of  
3 revenue, shall promulgate regulations for the verification of income of non-custodial parents  
4 used to determine child support payments. Said regulations shall require that all non-custodial  
5 parents present at least two forms of documentation that can be used to verify the individual's  
6 income. Said regulations shall also require third party verification of the non-custodial parent's  
7 income, and if said verification determines that false information was provided, that it be  
8 considered when determining child support payments and visitation rights of the individual  
9 supplying false information.
