An Act Establishing Criminal Penalties for Illegal Lobbying..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. “Chapter 271 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2006 official edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new section: -

3 “Section 51. Illegally Lobbying State Government.

4 “Any person found to have lobbied state government, in either the executive or the
5 legislative branches, or any subdivision thereof, in violation of the provisions of chapter 3 shall
6 be found guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by not more than 2 ½ years in a jail and a fine of
7 not more than \$10,000 or both for each instance thereof.
