An Act relative to vital records..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Any native American Indian whose certified birth record or copy thereof
2	contains a racial designation that is incorrect or missing may, without payment of a fee obtain
3	one certified copy of her or his birth record from which such incorrect racial designation has
4	been removed or corrected. The person requesting the birth record shall provide satisfactory
5	proof from a Native American Indian authority, or sworn and notarized statement to substantiate
6	their Native American Indian ancestry. The certificate issued shall not be marked or designated
7	"amended" solely for the reason set forth in this section. This Act shall take effect upon passage.
