An Act Erecting a Clara Barton Sign on I-395.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any policy or regulation of the Massachusetts Highway
- 2 Department to the contrary, the department is hereby authorized and directed to erect and
- 3 maintain two signs on Route I-395 at exit 5 northbound and southbound in the town of Oxford
- 4 marking and directing motorists to the birthplace of Clara Barton, founder of the American Red
- 5 Cross, teacher, national heroine, and native of Oxford, Massachusetts.
