The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act relative to noncriminal disposition of parking violations..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 20A ¹ / ₂ of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended on the
2	second line of the eighth paragraph thereof by deleting the word "two" at the end thereof and by
3	inserting in place thereof the word "one".
4	SECTION 2. Section $20A^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended on the
5	fourth line of the eighth paragraph thereof by inserting after the words "said vehicle" the
6	following: "and shall not issue a new motor vehicle registration to said person."
7	SECTION 3. Section $20A^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
8	inserting after the ninth paragraph the following new paragraph:
9	"If any person licensed to operate a motor vehicle in the commonwealth or having a
10	motor vehicle registered in the Commonwealth fails to appear in accordance with five or more
11	notices the parking clerk shall notify the registrar of motor vehicles who shall place the matter on
12	record and shall suspend, without a hearing, the persons license to operate a motor vehicle in the
13	Commonwealth until such time as the matter has been disposed of in accordance with law. The

14 registrar of motor vehicles shall also suspend without a hearing and shall not renew the person's 15 motor vehicle registration and shall not issue a new motor vehicle registration of any kind to said 16 person until after notice from the parking clerk that all such matters have been disposed of in 17 accordance with law. In the case of any person licensed to operate a motor vehicle in a state 18 other than the Commonwealth or having a motor vehicle registered in a state other than the 19 Commonwealth where said person has failed to appeal or appear in accordance with three of said 20 notices, notwithstanding any notification to the registrar, the parking clerk may notify the chief 21 of police or director of traffic or parking of said city or town that the vehicle involved in said 22 multiple violations shall be removed and stored, or otherwise immobilized by a mechanical 23 device, at the expense of the registered owner of said vehicle until such time as the matter has 24 been disposed of in accordance with law."

25 SECTION 4. Section 20A of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended on the 26 second line of the seventh paragraph thereof by deleting the word "two" at the end thereof and 27 by inserting the word "one".

28 SECTION 5. Section 20A of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended on the 29 fourth line of the seventh paragraph thereof by inserting after the words "said vehicle" the 30 following: "and shall not issue a new motor vehicle registration to said person".

31 SECTION 6. Section 20A of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
32 inserting after the eighth paragraph the following new paragraph:

33 "If any person licensed to operate a motor vehicle in the commonwealth or having a 34 motor vehicle registered in the Commonwealth fails to appear in accordance with five or more 35 notices the parking clerk shall notify the registrar of motor vehicles who shall place the matter on

36 record and shall suspend, without a hearing, the persons license to operate a motor vehicle in the 37 Commonwealth until such time as the matter has been disposed of in accordance with law. The 38 registrar of motor vehicles shall also suspend without a hearing and shall not renew the person's 39 motor vehicle registration and shall not issue a new motor vehicle registration of any kind to said 40 person until after notice from the parking clerk that all such matters have been disposed of in 41 accordance with law. In the case of any person licensed to operate a motor vehicle in a state 42 other than the Commonwealth or having a motor vehicle registered in a state other than the 43 Commonwealth where said person has failed to appeal or appear in accordance with three of said 44 notices, notwithstanding any notification to the registrar, the parking clerk may notify the chief 45 of police or director of traffic or parking of said city or town that the vehicle involved in said 46 multiple violations shall be removed and stored, or otherwise immobilized by a mechanical 47 device, at the expense of the registered owner of said vehicle until such time as the matter has 48 been disposed of in accordance with law."

SECTION 7. Section 22 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended in the second paragraph of subsection (c) on line two thereof by deleting the following words: "except a" and by inserting in place thereof the following: "including parking violations upon notice from the parking clerk, as provided for in sections 20A and 20A¹/₂ of chapter 90 of the General Laws, when a person fails to appear in accordance with five or more parking violation notices, when the parking clerk has notified the registrar of motor vehicles".

55 SECTION 8. Section 7V of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by 56 adding a new sub-section (d) as follows: "The registrar shall, on or before January 1, 2009 make 57 and implement rules and regulations relative to the issuance of certificates of inspection which 58 shall provide that said certificate of inspection shall not be issued to the registrant and or any

59 person licensed to operate a motor vehicle in the Commonwealth, until all parking violations on 60 record with the registrar marked to the person's drivers license number, pursuant to the 61 provisions of sections 20 and $20A\frac{1}{2}$ of chapter 90 of the General Laws, have been disposed of in 62 accordance with the law.

63 SECTION 9. Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law to the 64 contrary the registrar shall not renew or issue a new license to operate a motor vehicle in the 65 commonwealth to any person whose previous motor vehicle license is marked by the registrar for 66 non-renewal, in accordance with the provisions of sections 20A or 20A¹/₂ of chapter 90 of the 67 General Laws, until such time as all parking violations on record with the registrar have been 68 disposed of in accordance with law.

69 SECTION 10. Section 20A of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended on the 70 seventh line of the seventh paragraph by adding at the end thereof after the word "vehicle" the 71 following: "and an additional twenty dollar charge payable to city or town in which the violation 72 occurred, shall be assessed against the registered owner of said vehicle".

SECTION 11. Section 20A¹/₂ of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended on the seventh line of the eighth paragraph by adding at the end thereof after the word "vehicle" the following: "and an additional twenty dollar charge, payable to the city or town in which the violation occurred shall be assessed against the registered owner of said vehicle".
