An Act to Establish a Military Service Scholarship Program..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 16 of chapter 15A of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after the ninth paragraph the following paragraph:
- There shall be a Military Service Scholarship Program pursuant to section 16 of chapter
- 4 15A of the General Laws to provide full scholarships to the children, siblings or widowed
- 5 spouses of Massachusetts servicemen and servicewomen, who are killed or die or are severely
- 6 disabled from injuries received while in the performance of duties including authorized training
- duty; to children, siblings or widowed spouses of prisoners of war or military or service persons
- 8 missing in action in any foreign land, including but not limited to, Iraq and Afghanistan, whose
- 9 wartime service is credited to the commonwealth and whose service was Between September
- eleven two thousand one, and the termination of both the Iraq and Afghanistan campaign; to the
- children, siblings and widowed spouses of veterans whose service was credited to the
- 12 commonwealth and who were killed in action or otherwise died as a result of such service. Such
- scholarships shall be awarded by the council pursuant to its guidelines established to govern this
- program and shall go to those persons referenced above who are admitted to an institution of

- higher education in the commonwealth to pursue undergraduate studies. The guidelines shall
- include, but not be limited to, a waiver of mandatory fees, tuition, books, room and board, or
- 17 other school mandated related expenses.
