An Act Text of amendment (1) offered by Mr. Rosenberg to the pending Senate Ways and Means amendment (Senate, No. 3) to the House Bill making appropriations for the fiscal year 2010 for the maintenance of the departments, boards, commissions, institutions and certain activities of the Commonwealth, for interest, sinking fund and serial bond requirements and for certain permanent improvements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Reserved.
- 2 Section 70. It shall be a mandatory requirement that no less than ninety days prior to the

3 commencement of any procurement process undertaken pursuant to the provisions of sections

4 sixty-one to seventy-one for the design, construction, inspection, maintenance, , or modification

5 for work on the water storage facilities, that the governmental body shall make public

6 notification of said process by the following means:

7 1. Publish an appropriate notice in the Central Register, published by the Secretary of

9 SECTION _____. Section 2 is hereby amended by inserting after item 1599-3856 the

11 1599-6425 For a reserve to support municipal regionalization efforts in the 12 commonwealth; provided, that this item shall be used to provide grants and technical assistance 13 to districts and municipalities, including councils on government, counties, and regional planning 14 authorities that are applying on behalf of two or more municipal entities, in the areas of planning, 15 feasibility, transitional costs, and related subject areas to promote cost effective and efficient 16 delivery of local services by regionalization of services including, but not limited to, equipment, 17 hardware, facilities, staff, and operations; provided further, that the secretary of administration 18 and finance shall promulgate regulations to implement this item not later than September 1, 19 2009; and provided further, that grants and technical assistance may only be provided to support 20
