An Act relative to flea market vendors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The definition of “Transient Vendor” in Section 1 of Chapter 101 of the  
2 General Laws as so appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after  
3 the first sentence the following:-

4           “The provisions of this chapter may not apply to vendors and promoters in flea markets at  
5 the option of the city or town where the flea market is located by so called.”

6           SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 101 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
7 striking out the last sentence of this paragraph and inserting the following:-

8           “The provisions of this chapter will not apply to vendors and promoters in flea markets so  
9 called.”
