An Act relative to sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation act 2 and other appropriation acts for fiscal year 2010, the sums set forth in section 2 are hereby 3 appropriated from the General Fund unless specifically designated otherwise in this act or in 4 those appropriation acts, for the several purposes and subject to the conditions specified in this 5 act or in those appropriation acts, and 6 subject to the laws regulating the disbursement of public funds for the fiscal year ending 7 June 30, 2010. These sums shall be in addition to any amounts previously appropriated and 8 made available for the purposes of those items.
