An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Raynham as the SFC Jared C. Monti Bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. The State owned bridge on US Route 44 Cape Highway, over the Taunton
2	River, in the town of Raynham, shall be named the "SFC Jared C. Monti Bridge, Congressional
3	Medal of Honor Recipient," in honor of the late SFC Jared C. Monti who served his country in
4	Afghanistan. The department of highways shall erect suitable markers bearing said designation
5	in compliance with the standards of the department.
