An Act designating a certain bridge in the city of Taunton as the Sgt Shane Duffy Bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. The State owned bridge on Route 44, Winthrop Street, over the Three Mile
2	River in the City of Taunton shall be named the SGT Shane Duffy Bridge, in honor of the late
3	SGT Shane Duffy who served his country in Iraq. The department of highways shall erect
4	suitable markers bearing said designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
