An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Catherine Ann Ouellette, an employee of the Trial Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Notwithstanding any general or special, or rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial
2	court shall establish a sick leave bank for Catherine Ann Ouellette, an employee of the trial
3	court. Any employee of said department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or
4	vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by Catherine Ann Ouellette. Whenever Catherine
5	Ann Ouellette terminates employment with said department or request to dissolve the sick leave
6	bank, the balance of the sick leave bank time shall be transferred to the trial court paid sick leave
7	bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
8	that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
