## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Ten

An Act to provide an income tax exemption for families caring for their elderly relatives at home.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 3, Part B, paragraphs (b)(1), (c)(1A), and (2)(A) of Chapter 62 of
2	the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3	following new subparagraph:-
4	(D) an additional exemption of four thousand dollars if the taxpayer provided more than
5	one-half of the support for an elderly relative who has attained the age of seventy before the
6	taxable year, provided that the elderly relative resided with the taxpayer for more than six
7	months of the taxable year and provided further that the adjusted gross income of the taxpayer
8	does not exceed forty thousand dollars for the year in which the exemption is being claimed.
9	SECTION 2. The commissioner shall adopt rules and regulations governing the
10	provisions of this act that are not consistent with the provisions contained herein.
1	SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall be effective for taxable years beginning

12 January 1, 2010.
