An Act Validating the Election of a Charter Commission in the City of Holyoke..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any defect or omissions in the procedure for the
- 2 placement of the question on the ballot at the 2009 city election in the city of Holyoke relative to
- 3 the election of a charter commission and notwithstanding any defects or omissions in the
- 4 wording of that question, the election of a charter commission established for the purpose of
- 5 amending the city's charter and all actions taken by the charter commission pursuant to that
- 6 election are hereby ratified, validated and confirmed to the same extent as if the question was
- 7 properly placed in proper form as required by chapter 43B of the General Laws.
- 8 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the proposed
- 9 charter revisions recommended by the Holyoke charter commission and submitted to the city
- 10 council pursuant to section 9 of chapter 43B of the General Laws shall be submitted to the voters
- of the city of Holyoke for their approval at the city election to be held on November 8, 2011.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
