An Act RELATIVE TO ASSAULT AND BATTERY ATTEMPTING TO DISARM A POLICE OFFICER..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Whoever commits an offense set forth in section thirteen D of chapter two
- 2 hundred and sixty-five of the Massachusetts General Laws where said offense includes the
- 3 attempt to disarm a police officer in the performance of his duty, shall be punished by
- 4 imprisonment in the state prison for not more than ten years, or by a fine of not more than one
- 5 thousand dollars and imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for not more than two and
- 6 one-half years.
