Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the
- 2 contrary, the board of elementary and secondary education shall update 603 CMR 7.06(25)(d) to
- 3 require an approved program for teachers of students with moderate disabilities to include
- 4 instruction on the appropriate use of augmentative and alternative communication and other
- 5 assistive technologies.
- 6 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the
- 7 contrary, the board of elementary and secondary education shall update 603 CMR
- 8 7.06(26)(b)(12) to require an approved program for teachers of students with severe disabilities
- 9 to also include instruction on the appropriate use of augmentative and alternative communication
- and other assistive technologies.
