An Act authorizing the city of North Adams to continue the employment of public safety commissioner E. John Morocco..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, E. John  
2 Morocco, Commissioner of Public Safety for the City of North Adams, may continue to serve in  
3 such position past the mandatory retirement age otherwise required by law. The appointing  
4 authority may, at its own expense, require that E. John Morocco be examined by an impartial  
5 physician to determine that he is mentally and physically capable of performing the duties of that  
6 position. Deductions shall continue to be made from the regular compensation of E. John  
7 Morocco under chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service performed hereunder.

8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
