An Act to let child support come home.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 18 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2	inserting after the first paragraph the following paragraph:
3	Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, a recipient
4	shall not be required to include a child in the assistance unit or to assign that child's support to
5	the department. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the
6	department shall not count any child support collections paid on behalf of a child who is not
7	receiving benefits paid by the department in determining the eligibility for benefits of other
8	family members.
