An Act relative to prescription advantage start dates..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 39(a)(1) of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amending chapter 19A, by striking the words “is sixty-five of age or older;” in
3 line 6, and inserting the following words: “turns sixty-five within the month their coverage
4 becomes effective;”

5 SECTION 2. Section 39(m) of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
6 Edition, is hereby amending chapter 19A, by inserting before the word “Coverage”, in line153
7 the following words: “Persons who submit an application within three months of their sixty-fifth
8 birthday, and are deemed eligible to receive benefits, shall begin receiving benefits on the first
9 day of the month in which they turn sixty-five.”

10 SECTION 3. The Department shall amend regulations 651CMR 15.05 and 651CMR
11 15.06 to reflect the earliest effective date of coverage adopted by Medicare Part D.
