Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 18 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004

4 Section 18. Each candidate and each treasurer of a political committee shall file with the

director or, if the candidate seeks public office at a city or town election, or if the committee is

organized for the purpose of a city or town election, with the city or town clerk, reports of

contributions received and expenditures made on forms to be prescribed by the director. A

candidate for nomination or election to the office of mayor in a city and any non-elected political

committee organized on behalf of such candidate, who files such reports in accordance with

clause (b), shall file a copy of any such report with the director. A committee organized under

the provisions of section five to favor or oppose a question submitted to the voters shall file its

reports with the director if the question appears on ballots at a state election, or with the city or

town clerk if the question appears on ballots at a city or town election or for use in a city or town
