An Act providing improved management of state forests..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 34A of Chapter 132 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 43, after the word "require.", the
- 3 following:- The commissioner may require that any bid for the removal of timber or other forest
- 4 products under this section shall include such improvements to the forest as the commissioner
- 5 deems necessary. Any such bid or contract requirement shall not result in a reduction of force or
- 6 displacement of persons employed by the department performing similar responsibilities.
