An Act Relative to harbor pilots.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 103 is hereby amended by adding the following sections:
- 2 Section 36 Solicitation Prohibited.
- No person commissioned as a pilot under Chapter 103 of the General Laws shall engage
- 4 in any work outside the scope of their commission that relates to or amounts to the solicitation of
- 5 business for a company engaged in providing tugboat services for ships in the commonwealth.
- 6 Section 37 Enforcement and Penalties –
- 7 Violations of this Act or the regulations promulgated under this Act may be prosecuted
- 8 by the Office of the Attorney General or the District Attorney for Suffolk County in any
- 9 Massachusetts court of competent jurisdiction. Except for the penalties provided in Section 3,
- above, violations of the Act or the regulations promulgated under this Act shall be punished by a
- civil penalty of no more than \$20,000 per occurrence, or a criminal penalty of no more than
- 12 \$20,000 per occurrence.
