Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- In G.L. Chapter 1760 by inserting after section 16 the following new section:
- 2 Section 16A. No carrier may deny coverage under any health benefit plan by virtue of the
- 3 fact that the insured was under the influence of alcohol or drugs not prescribed by a physician at
- 4 the time an injury was incurred.
