An Act to enhance opportunities for housing among recipients of transitional assistance..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department  
2 of transitional assistance shall each month deposit into escrow accounts for the benefit of  
3 homeless individuals and families receiving assistance under the program of emergency aid to  
4 elders, disabled and children, pursuant to Chapter 117A of the General Laws, or receiving  
5 assistance under the program of transitional aid to families with dependent children, pursuant to  
6 Chapter 118 of the General Laws, an amount equal to the amount by which the department  
7 reduces the grants of said individuals and families for lack of shelter expenses. Such escrowed  
8 funds shall be available to such individuals and families to obtain and retain permanent housing  
9 and to remove barriers to obtaining and retaining housing and shall not be countable toward  
10 otherwise applicable asset limits.
