## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act creating a jail diversion program..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 19 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,
- 2 are hereby amended by inserting after section 21 the following section:-
- 3 Section 22. Subject to appropriation, the commissioner shall establish a jail diversion
- 4 program. Such program shall provide opportunities to divert individuals with mental illness out
- 5 of the criminal justice system and into community based mental health and substance abuse
- 6 services where such diversion is clinically appropriate and consistent with public safety. This
- 7 program shall establish, monitor and evaluate pilot projects and ongoing programs in cities,
- 8 towns or regions of the commonwealth, as determined by the commissioner, taking into
- 9 consideration available resources and need, using promising or established program designs for
- 10 effectuating clinically appropriate, safe and effective diversion of such individuals.
