An Act to the placement of automatic external defibrillators..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by placing after Section 26G the following section:- Section 26H. In  
3 any city or town which accepts the provisions of this section, the board of health or other  
4 licensing authority of such city or town shall promulgate rules and regulations, subject to the  
5 approval of the Office of Emergency Medical Services in the Department of Public Health,  
6 requiring the placement of Automatic External Defibrillators (AED) in proper locations within  
7 private business open to the public. Such regulations may detail the type of business required to  
8 provide access to the placement of Automatic External Defibrillators.
