## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

## In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act Establishing a Massachusetts Comparative Cost Effectiveness Institute...

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the secretary of
- 2 health and human services, in consultation with the health care quality and cost council, shall
- 3 hereby establish an independent entity, known as the Massachusetts Comparative Cost
- 4 Effectiveness Institute. Said independent entity shall examine, research and issue guidelines on
- 5 the comparative effectiveness of medical procedures, drugs, devices, and biologics, so that
- 6 research results can be used as a basis for health care purchasing and payment decisions that
- 7 limit cost, create efficiencies and eliminate clinical waste thereby reducing inappropriate,
- 8 ineffective or redundant care.
- 9 SECTION 2. In concert with results from study commission findings, as mandated by
- Section 53 of Chapter 305 of the Acts of 2008, the secretary shall consider existing state and
- 11 national models, including, but not limited to, the Institute for Clinical and Economic Review,
- 12 the Washington State Health Care Authority's Health Technology Assessment program, the
- 13 National Institute for Health and Clinical Excellence in Britain, and the Institut für Qualität und

- 14 Wirtschaftlichkeit im Gesundheitswesen in Germany regarding the development of the
- independent entity.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
