## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act relative to restroom access for medical reasons..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Not withstanding any General of Special Law to the contrary, any business
2	or place where members of the public have access as invitees or licenses shall provide access to
3	any restroom within said business or said place to anyone with a pressing medical condition,
4	including pregnancy, ulcerative colitis or Crohn's disease. An individual requesting such access
5	must present a physician's statement or identification card stating the medical condition prior to
6	access to any restroom.

7 The failure to comply with the provisions of this law by any said business or said place8 shall be punishable by a fine of one hundred dollars.
