An Act Relative to Cigar Bars..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no municipality,
2	through act of its board of public health or municipal health department, may unreasonably
3	restrict, nor prohibit the operation of a smoking bar, as defined by section 5 of chapter 270, so
4	long as such smoking bar complies with the provisions of this chapter. Such reasonable
5	restrictions and requirements for the licensed operation of a smoking bar, as provided under this
6	chapter shall, shall be permitted.
