An Act regarding uniform police identifications cards..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 41, section 98D of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- 2 the current section and inserting in its place the following section:
- 3 Each city or town, and the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority Transit Police
- 4 Department, shall issue to every full time police officer employed by it an identification card
- 5 bearing the officer's photograph and identity. The secretary of public safety shall have the
- 6 authority to promulgate regulations relative to the issuance of identification cards to police
- 7 officers. Such card shall be carried on the officer's person, and shall be exhibited upon lawful
- 8 request for purposes of identification.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 22C, section 19 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:
- The secretary of public safety shall have the authority to promulgate regulations relative
- 12 to the issuance of identification cards to state police officers.
