shall be appointed by the Senate President, 1 by the Senate Minority Leader, 2 members from the

House Minority Leader, the Attorney General or her designee, and 10 persons to be appointed by

an investigation and study relative to the ability of independent auto repair businesses to repair automobiles after the expiration of any warranty. The commission's investigation shall include, but not be limited to: determining, whether independent repair businesses have the ability and means to obtain necessary tools and information to repair automobiles and receive proper education in the repair of such vehicles.

Said commission shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerks of the house of representatives and senate who shall forward the same to the joint committee as determined by the house and senate on or before January 31, 2012.
